New Business

-Kristina – In Policies & Procedures, it is noted that a member cannot hold the same service position more than two terms consecutively. Is a Steering committee position with a 1-year sobriety requirement the same as a Steering committee with a 10-year sobriety requirement? Requesting further clarification.
